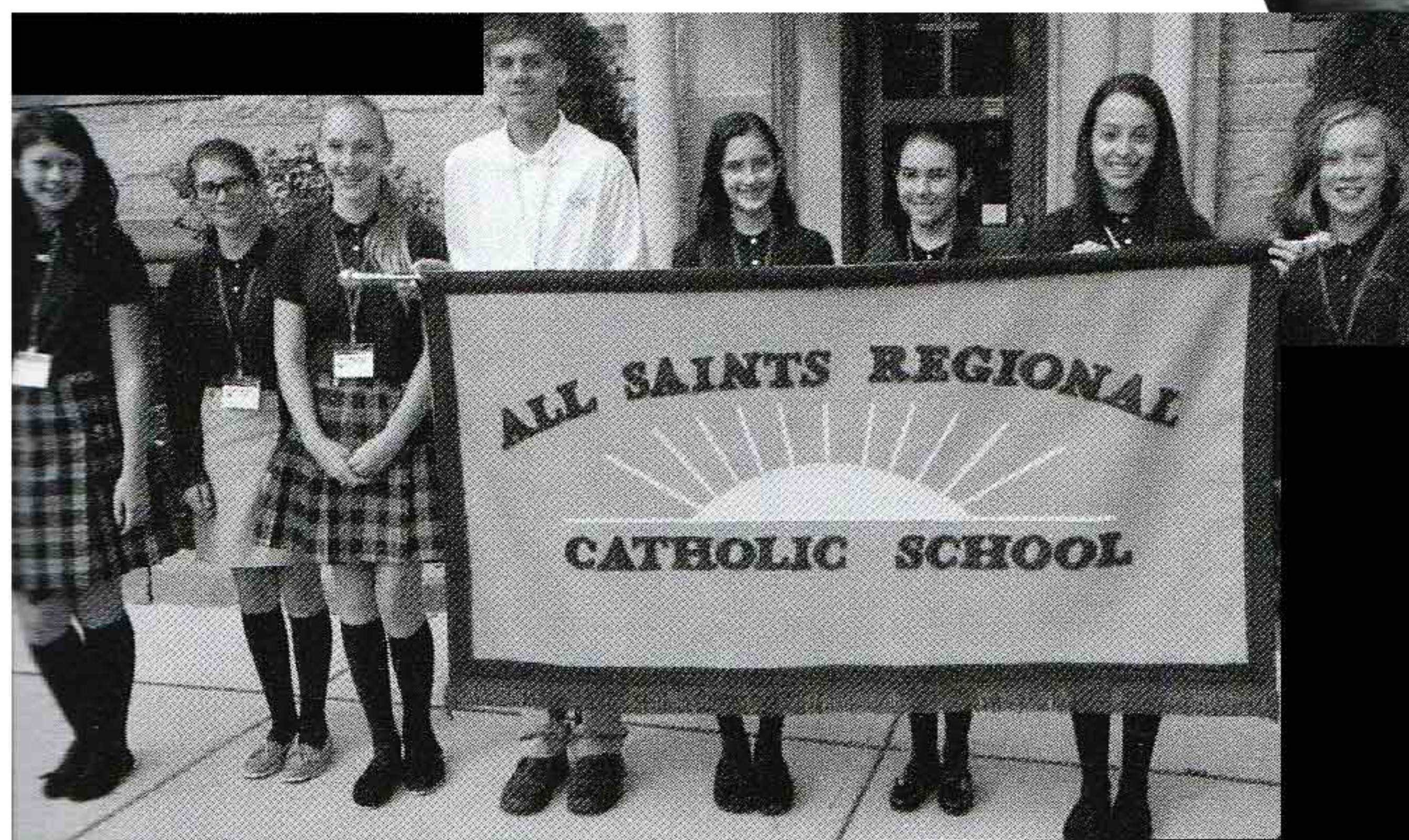
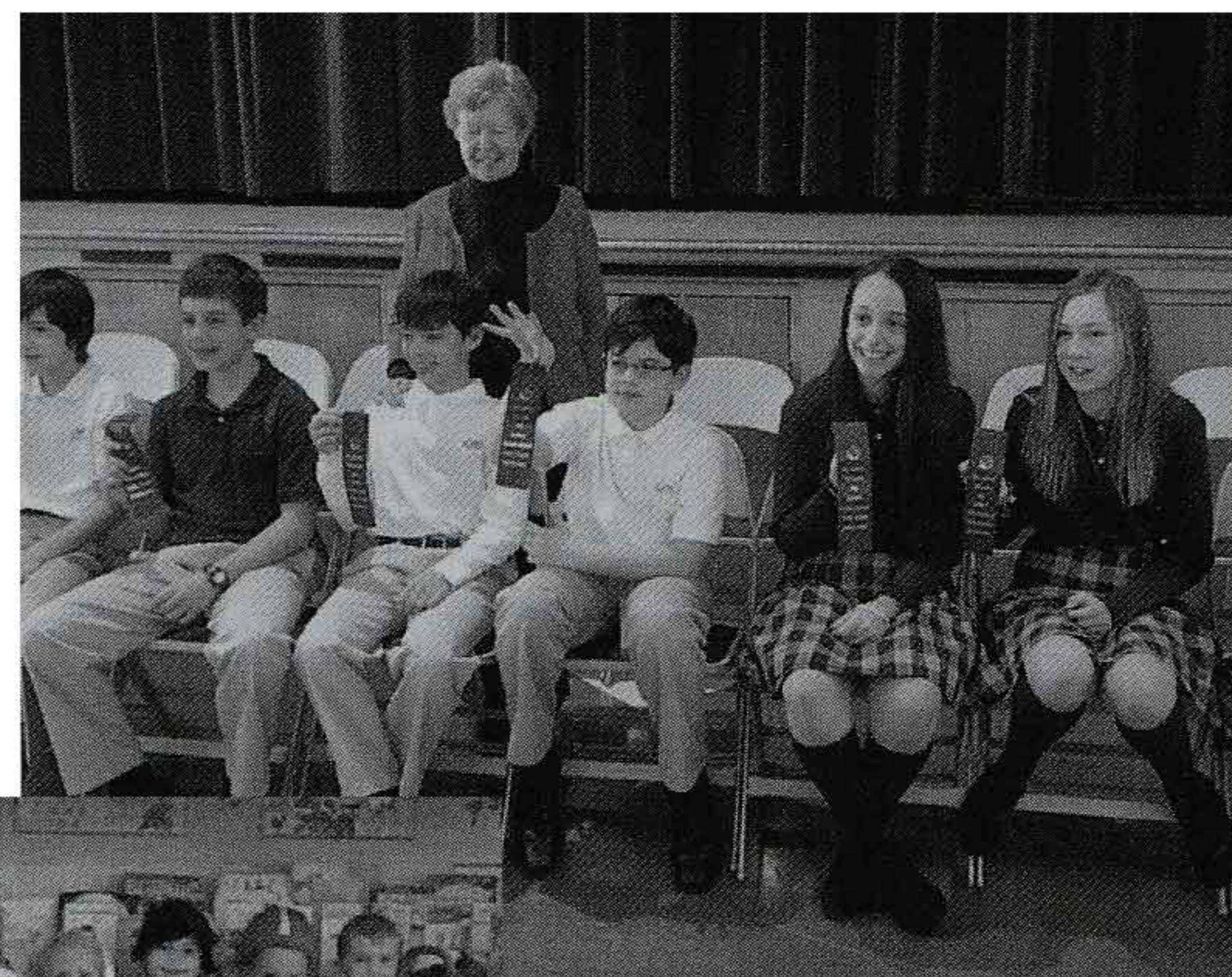
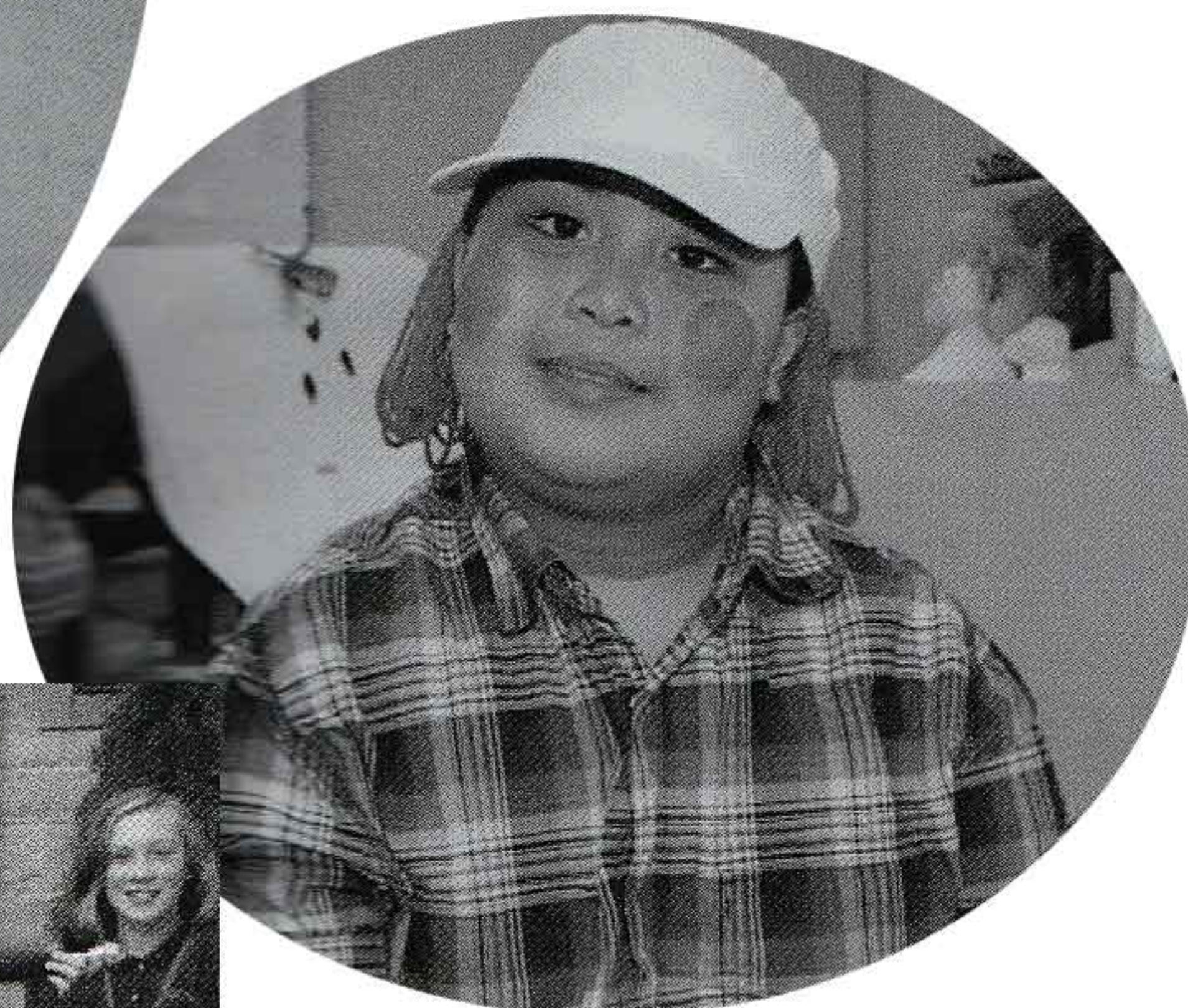
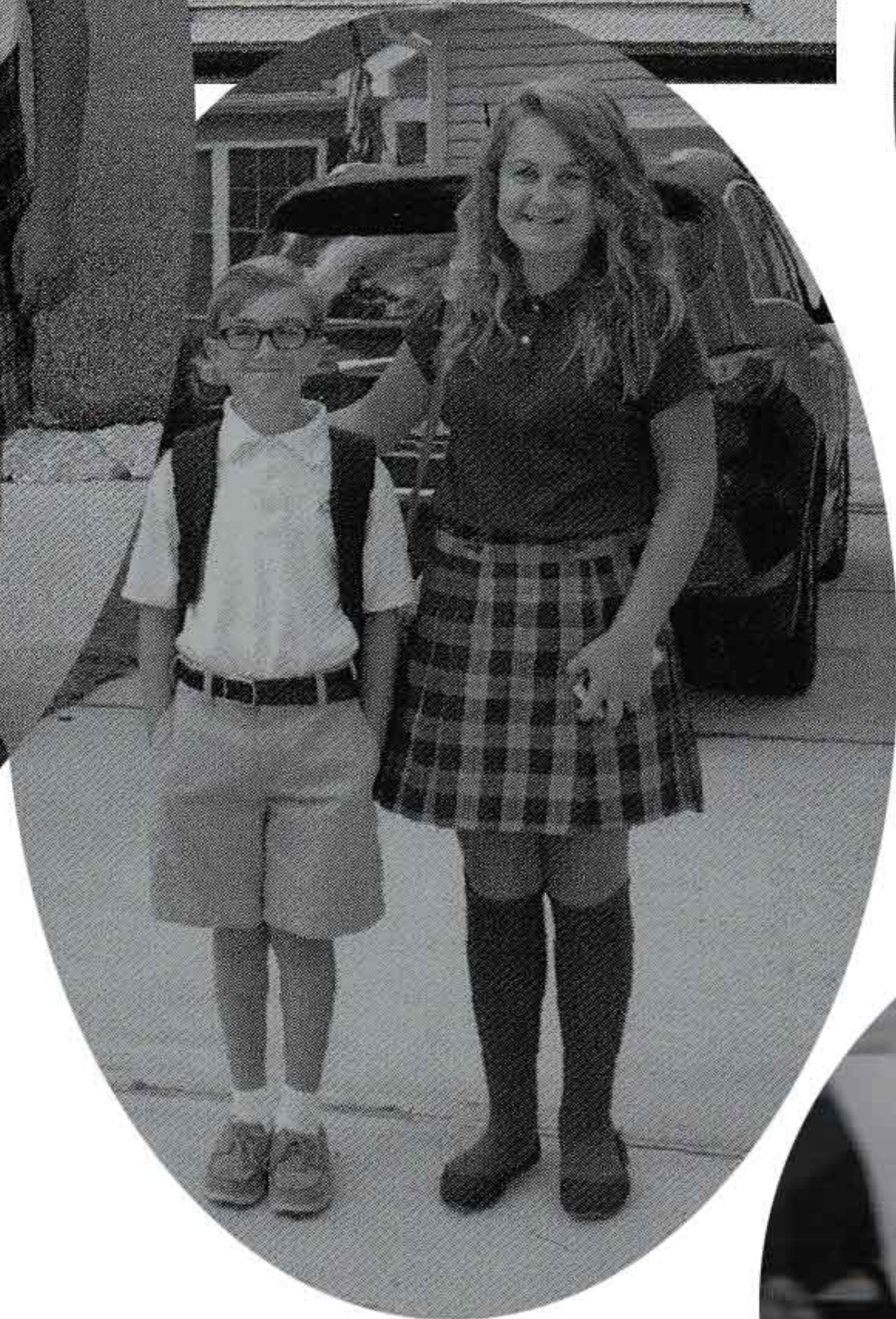
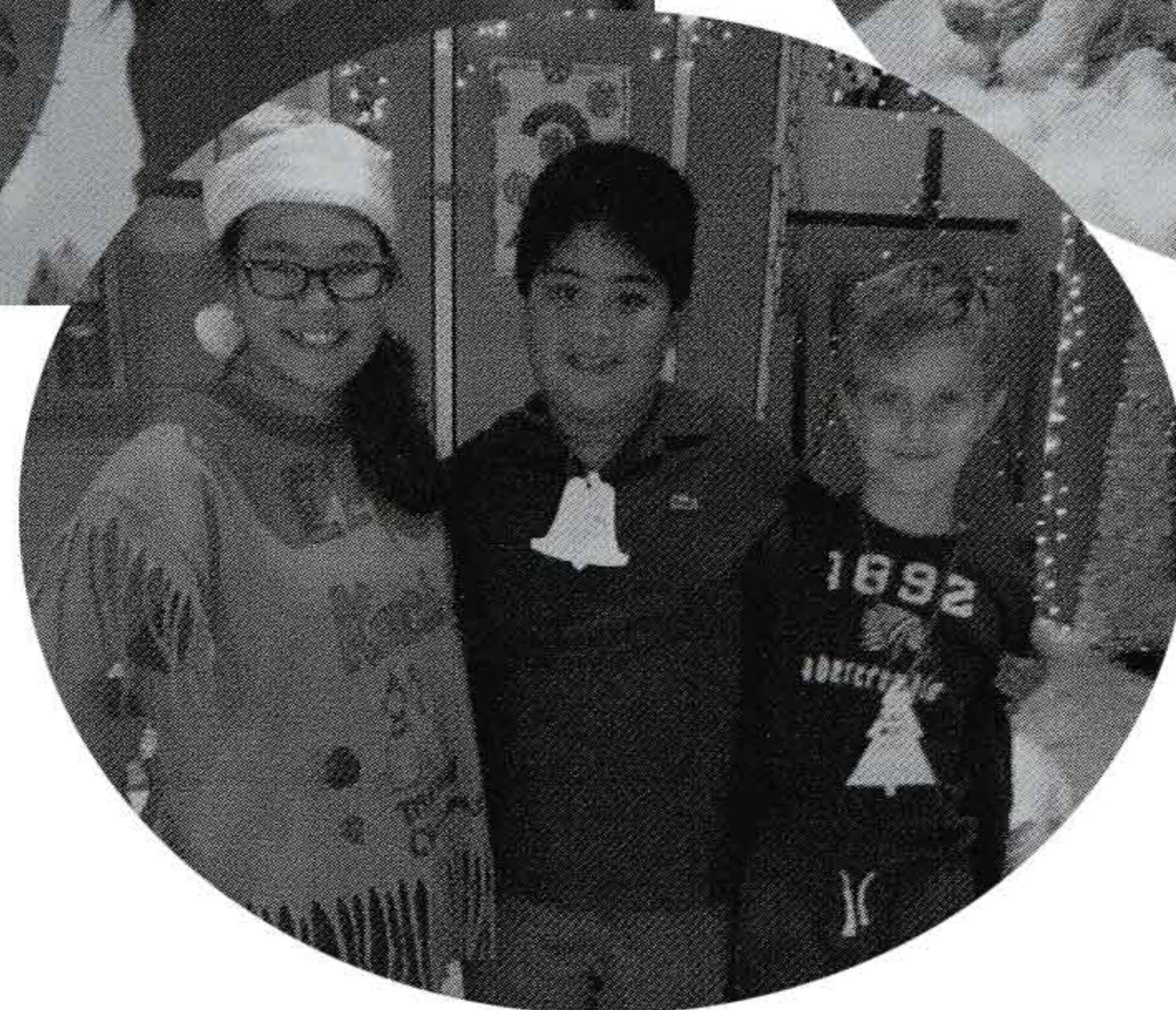
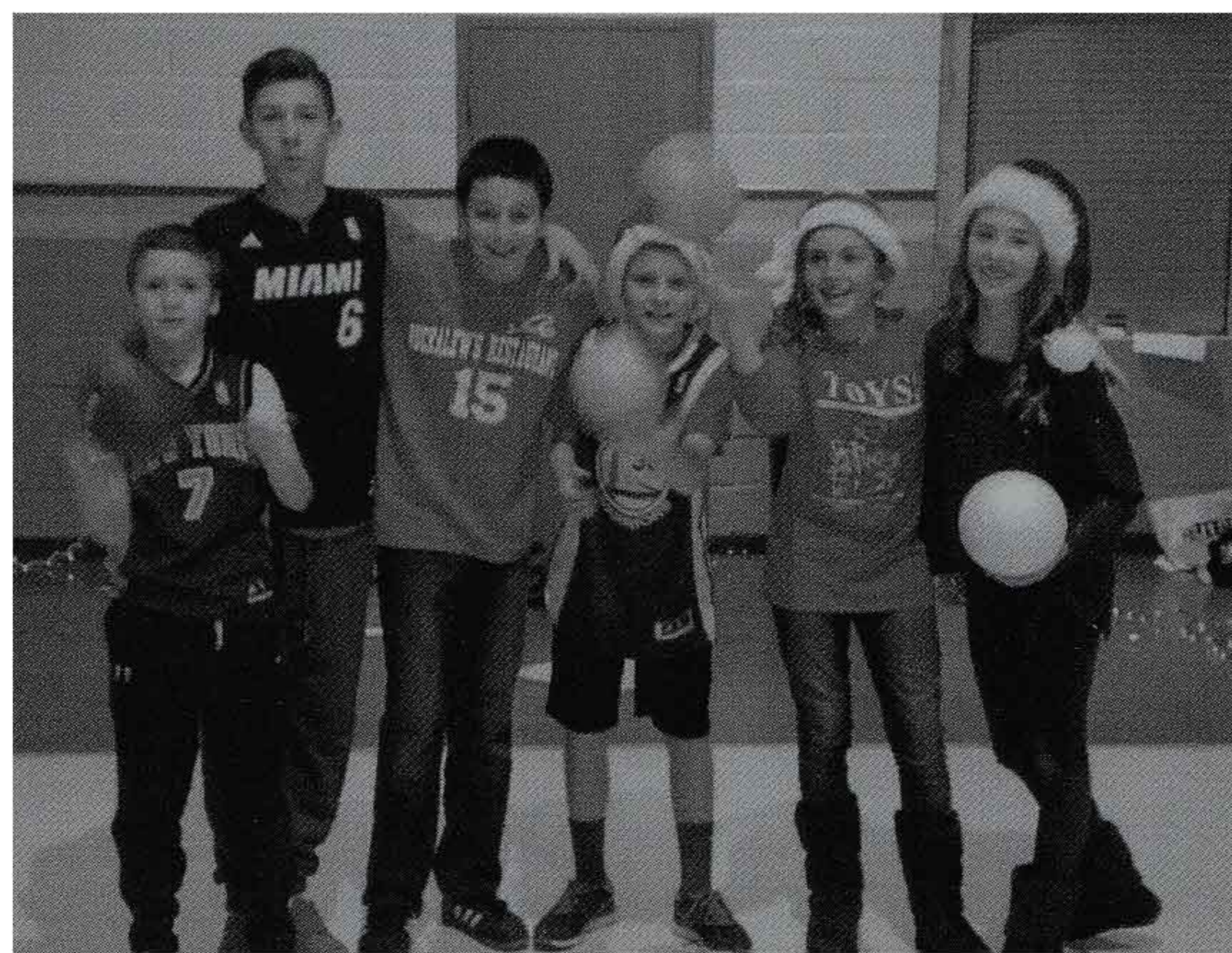






All Saints Girls Basketball Is a Perfect 15-0 in '15
